

AB 1433 – Free Dental Screening for Low-income Families

To help low-income families meet the requirements of AB 1433, the kindergarten oral health assessment law, HealthCare Volunteer, a non-profit organization, has launched a statewide free dental screening program to help connect kindergarten students to dentists. Parents can register their children for a free screening using the website.

To qualify, parents must be at or below the [2007 federal poverty level](#), \$20,650 for a family of four. To verify qualification, parents can submit either the previous year's tax return or a statement that shows they did not have to file a tax return to HealthCare Volunteer or bring a copy of their tax return with them to the screening.
